THE FORT CHILLON ENTERS INTO RESISTANCE ETHICAL STRIKE AGAINST THE OBLIGATION TO CONTROL THE SANITARY PASS

It is with consternation and amazement that the team of the Fort Chillon museum in Veytaux/Montreux has acknowledged the announcement of the Federal Council, establishing the obligation to control the sanitary pass in all public places from September 13, 2021.

The great majority of the employees of the Fort Chillon have decided to go on an **"ethical strike against the obligation of sanitary pass control"** imposed on Swiss companies.

From Wednesday, September 15th, the Bunker will be kept open to the public by its employees on strike against the sanitary pass control.

The entire staff of the Fort Chillon believes that :

- The Federal Council is using controls in cultural and leisure places as means of pressure on citizens to enforce vaccination. We refuse to be used in this way!
- Whether or not to be vaccinated is a matter of free choice and is part of a personal, private and confidential process, specific to each individual.
- The decision of the Federal Council jeopardizes thousands of businesses, thousands of jobs and introduces a sneaky hierarchy of value between citizens.

The employees of the Fort Chillon therefore refuse to sort, to monitor, to discriminate the visitors and customers because from their point of view we are all equal!

Representing the employees of the Fort Chillon, the Management therefore asks the Federal Council to cancel the obligation of sanitary pass control in public places.

Our Museum presents to the public a part of the "Swiss History" cherished by General Guisan: the Swiss National Redoubt. We are setting up an **Ethical Redoubt** in which we look forward to welcoming you without distinction.
